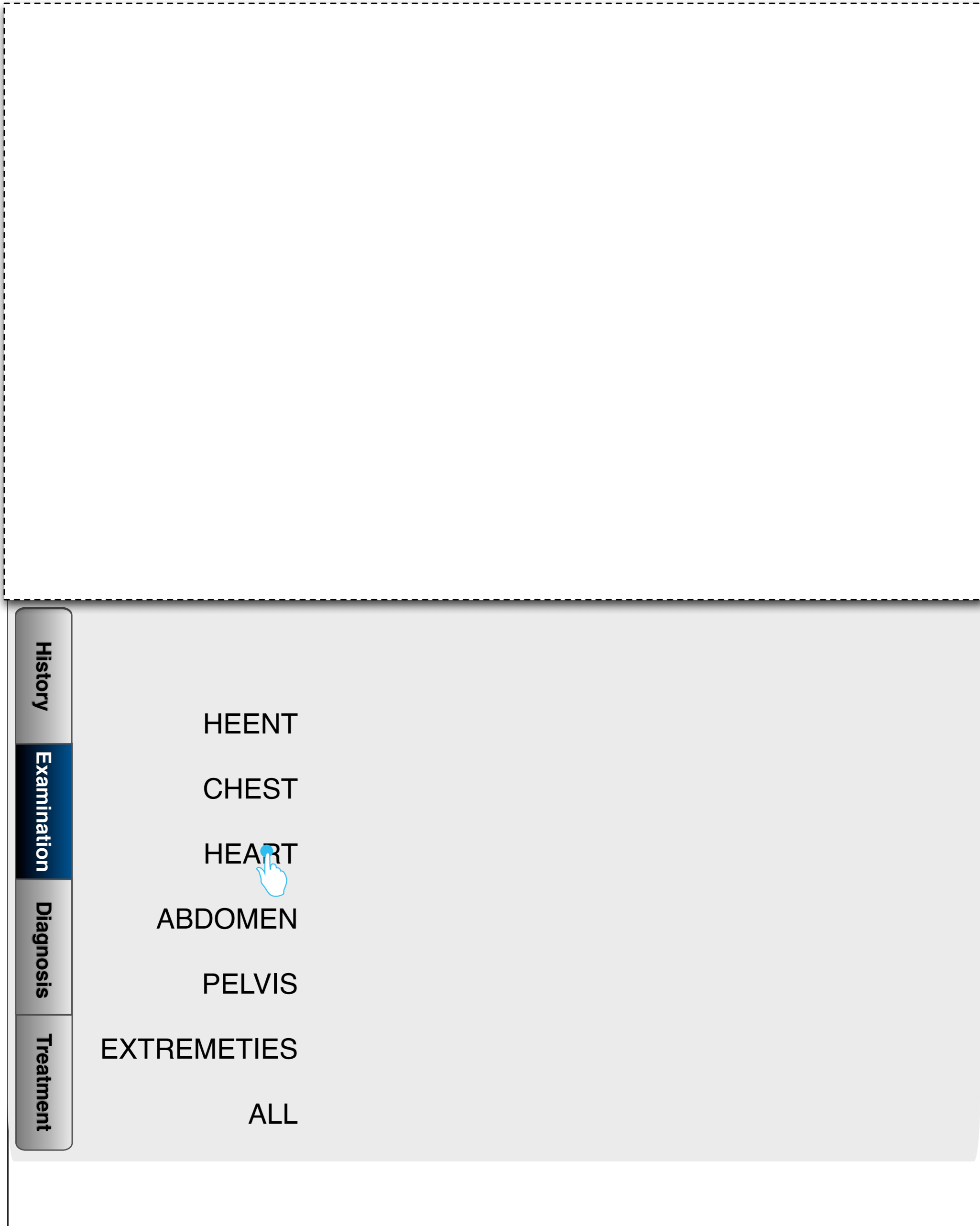

Under the Examination tab, the doctor has options to select one of the categories to select a SIGN or multiple SIGNS to add to the patient record before diagnosis;

He also has an option to select the ALL , to select option from an exhaustive list of SIGNS that has all the list



The doctor can either scroll through the list of signs or start typing in the SIGN to get filtered results on the box below

Check boxes are used to select multiple SIGNS and are populated on the box above the SEARCH BOX(shown in the next page)
